An heirloom birth 11 12 certificate must contain the same information as, and have the same 13 effect of, a certified copy of another birth record. The department 14 shall prescribe a fee for the issuance of an heirloom birth certificate in an amount that does not exceed \$50 [\$30]. 15 16 heirloom birth certificate must be printed on high-quality paper with the appearance of parchment not smaller than 11 inches by 14 17 18 inches. The department shall deposit 50 percent of the proceeds 19 [Proceeds] from the sale of heirloom birth certificates to the 20 21 credit of the childhood immunization account and the other 50 percent to the credit of the undedicated portion of the general 22

revenue fund. The childhood immunization account is an account in

the general revenue fund. Money in the account may be used only by

- 1 the Department of State Health Services for:
- 2 (1) making grants to fund childhood immunizations and
- 3 related education programs; and
- 4 (2) [shall be deposited to the credit of the general
- 5 revenue fund. An amount not to exceed the costs of administering
- 6 this section as determined by the comptroller shall be appropriated
- 7 to the department for administering this section.
- 8 <u>(c) The department may sell an heirloom birth certificate</u>
- 9 only for an individual born in this state.
- 10 SECTION 2. As soon as possible after the effective date of
- 11 this Act, the Department of State Health Services shall begin the
- 12 process of redesigning the form of the heirloom birth certificate
- in accordance with Section 192.0021, Health and Safety Code, as
- 14 amended by this Act. The department may appoint an advisory
- 15 committee to assist the department in soliciting donated designs
- and selecting the best designs. Until the new designs are selected,
- 17 the department shall continue to use the design in use on the
- 18 effective date of this Act.
