2	relating to certain unlawful employment practices.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Section 21.055, Labor Code, is amended to read as
5	follows:
6	Sec. 21.055. RETALIATION. An employer, labor union, or
7	employment agency commits an unlawful employment practice if the
8	employer, labor union, or employment agency retaliates or
9	discriminates against a person <u>because that person</u> [who], under
10	this chapter:
11	(1) opposes a discriminatory practice;
12	<pre>(2) makes or files a charge;</pre>
13	(3) files a complaint; or
14	(4) testifies, assists, or participates in any manner
15	in opposition to a discriminatory practice or in an investigation,
16	proceeding, or hearing conducted under this chapter.
17	SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies to a
18	claim alleging an unlawful employment practice that is filed with
19	the Texas Workforce Commission civil rights division on or after
20	the effective date of this Act. A claim filed before that date is
21	governed by the law in effect on the date the claim is filed, and the
22	former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
23	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
24	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
