4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 201.1055, Transportation Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	Sec. 201.1055. AGREEMENTS WITH PRIVATE ENTITIES. <u>(a)</u>
8	Notwithstanding any other law, including Subchapter A, Chapter
9	2254, Government Code, Chapters 2165, 2166, and 2167, Government
10	Code, and Sections 202.052, 202.053, 203.051, 203.052, and 223.001
11	of this code, the department and a private entity that offers the
12	best value to the state may enter into an agreement that includes:
13	(1) <u>site development and the</u> [ <del>both</del> ] design and
14	construction of a building and related facility that supports
15	department operations on:
16	(A) department-owned real property; or
17	(B) real property owned by the private entity
18	[district office headquarters facility located in a county with a
19	population of 3.3 million or more];
20	(2) a lease of department-owned real property [ <del>in a</del>
21	district that includes a county with a population of 3.3 million or
22	<pre>more] to the private entity;</pre>
23	(3) a provision authorizing the private entity to
24	construct and retain ownership of a building or related facility on

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1 property <u>owned by the entity or</u> leased to the entity under 2 Subdivision (2); [<del>and</del>]

3 (4) a provision under which the department agrees to 4 enter into an agreement to <u>acquire or</u> lease with an option or 5 options to purchase <u>real property described in Subdivision (1) that</u> 6 <u>is owned by the private entity, and</u> a building <u>and related facility</u> 7 constructed on <u>the property or on property</u> leased to the entity 8 under Subdivision (2); and

9 <u>(5) a provision under which the department agrees to</u> 10 <u>enter into an agreement to exchange department-owned real property</u> 11 <u>as whole or partial consideration for a building and related</u> 12 <u>facility described in Subdivision (1)</u>.

13 (b) Notwithstanding Section 202.024, the commission may 14 <u>authorize the executive director to execute a deed exchanging</u> 15 <u>department-owned real property under Subsection (a)(5).</u>

16 (c) Prior to signing an agreement under this section to 17 lease with an option or options to purchase, the Texas 18 Transportation Commission shall determine whether bond financing 19 or lease with an option or options to purchase is the most 20 cost-effective alternative for the acquisition of the building or 21 related facility.

22 (d) A lease agreement under this section shall provide for 23 the lease payments to apply to the purchase price of the building or 24 related facility and shall contain the agreed price to purchase the 25 building or related facility if the department exercises that 26 option.

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(e) Prior to signing an agreement under this section to

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exchange department-owned property with a private entity for a 1 2 building or related facility described in Subsection (a)(1), the commission shall determine whether the value of the building or 3 related facility owned by the private entity is equal to or greater 4 5 than the value of the department-owned property. 6 SECTION 2. Section 221.001(1), Transportation Code, is 7 amended to read as follows: 8 (1) "Highway" includes a public road or part of a 9 public road and a bridge, culvert, building, or other necessary structure related to a public road. 10 SECTION 3. Section 2166.302, Government Code, is amended by 11 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as 12 follows: 13 14 (a) Except as provided by Subsections [Subsection] (b) and 15 (c), the commission shall adopt uniform general conditions to be incorporated into all building construction contracts made by the 16 17 state, including a contract for a project excluded from this chapter by Section 2166.003, but not including a contract for a 18

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20 (c) Subsection (a) does not apply to a project constructed

project excluded from this chapter by Section 2166.004.

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SECTION 4. The changes in law made by this Act to Section 23 2166.302, Government Code, apply only to a contract for which the 24 Texas Department of Transportation first advertises or otherwise 25 solicits bids, proposals, offers, or qualifications on or after the 26 effective date of this Act. A contract for which the Texas 27 Department of Transportation first advertised or otherwise

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1 solicited bids, proposals, offers, or qualifications before that 2 date is governed by the law in effect when the first advertisement 3 or solicitation was given, and the former law is continued in effect 4 for that purpose.

5 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
