- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 221.001(1), Transportation Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (1) "Highway" includes a public road or part of a
- 8 public road and a bridge, culvert, <u>building</u>, or other necessary
- 9 structure related to a public road.
- SECTION 2. Section 2166.302, Government Code, is amended by
- 11 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to read as
- 12 follows:
- (a) Except as provided by <u>Subsections</u> [<u>Subsection</u>] (b) <u>and</u>
- 14 (c), the commission shall adopt uniform general conditions to be
- 15 incorporated into all building construction contracts made by the
- 16 state, including a contract for a project excluded from this
- 17 chapter by Section 2166.003, but not including a contract for a
- 18 project excluded from this chapter by Section 2166.004.
- (c) Subsection (a) does not apply to a project constructed
- 20 by and for the Texas Department of Transportation.
- 21 SECTION 3. The changes in law made by this Act to Section
- 22 2166.302, Government Code, apply only to a contract for which the
- 23 Texas Department of Transportation first advertises or otherwise
- 24 solicits bids, proposals, offers, or qualifications on or after the

- 1 effective date of this Act. A contract for which the Texas
- 2 Department of Transportation first advertised or otherwise
- 3 solicited bids, offers, or qualifications before that date is
- 4 governed by the law in effect when the first advertisement or
- 5 solicitation was given, and the former law is continued in effect
- 6 for that purpose.
- 7 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 8 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 9 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 10 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 11 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
