13	practitioner for a participant in the group benefits program
14	without the approval of that practitioner.
15	(c) This section does not apply to a generic substitution
16	made in compliance with Subchapter A, Chapter 562, Occupations
17	<u>Code.</u>
18	SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 1575, Insurance Code, is
19	amended by adding Section 1575.171 to read as follows:

21	PROHIBITED. (a) In this section, "drug," "pharmacist,"
22	"pharmacy," "practitioner," and "prescription drug order" have the
