- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 4151, Insurance Code, as
- 5 effective April 1, 2005, is amended by adding Section 4151.154 to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 4151.154. AUDIT PRACTICES. (a) Audit practices used
- 8 by a pharmacy benefit manager may consist only of methods and
- 9 procedures that are recognized as equitable to the pharmacy benefit
- 10 manager and the pharmacy audited. The commissioner shall adopt
- 11 rules as necessary to implement this subsection.
- 12 (b) A pharmacy benefit manager may not recover money owed by
- a pharmacy to the pharmacy benefit manager, as shown by an audit of
- 14 the pharmacy, by reducing payments to the pharmacy from the
- 15 pharmacy benefit manager before the audit results, including any
- 16 challenges to the audit, are final and unappealable.
- 17 <u>(c) A pharmacy benefit manager may not use extrapolation</u>
- 18 <u>calculations in an audit of a pharmacy.</u>
- 19 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- to an audit performed by a pharmacy benefit manager on or after the
- 21 effective date of this Act. An audit performed by a pharmacy
- 22 benefit manager before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 23 the law in effect immediately before that date, and that law is
- 24 continued in effect for that purpose.

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
