A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to licensing and regulation of auctioneers.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 1802.001, Occupations Code, is amended
- 5 by amending Subdivisions (2), (3), and (5) and adding Subdivision
- 6 (4-a) to read as follows:
- 7 (2) "Associate auctioneer" means an individual who,
- 8 for compensation, is employed by and under the direct supervision
- 9 of an [a licensed] auctioneer licensed under this chapter to sell or
- 10 offer to sell property at an auction.
- 11 (3) "Auction" means the sale of property through means
- 12 of exchanges between an auctioneer and members of an audience
- 13 consisting of a series of invitations for offers made by the
- 14 auctioneer, offers by audience members, and the acceptance by the
- 15 <u>auctioneer of the highest or most favorable offer.</u> The use of
- written bids, media technology, or mailings as part of a promotion,
- 17 bidding, or acceptance or any other part of a transaction does not
- 18 exclude the transaction from being classified as an auction [by
- 19 competitive bid].
- 20 (4-a) "Auction company operator" means a person who is
- 21 not an owner of an auction company but who has a vested financial
- 22 interest in the auction company.
- 23 (5) "Auctioneer" means any person [an individual] who
- 24 conducts [sells] or offers to conduct an [sell property at] auction

- 1 [, with or without receiving valuable consideration, as a bid
- 2 caller].
- 3 SECTION 2. Section 1802.002, Occupations Code, is amended
- 4 to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 1802.002. APPLICABILITY. This chapter does not apply
- 6 to:
- 7 (1) a sale conducted by order of a United States court
- 8 under Title 11, United States Code;
- 9 (2) a sale conducted by an employee of the United
- 10 States, this state, or a political subdivision of this state in the
- 11 course and scope of employment;
- 12 (3) [a sale conducted by a charitable or nonprofit
- 13 organization, if the auctioneer receives no compensation;
- 14 $\left[\frac{4}{4}\right]$ a sale conducted by an individual of the
- 15 individual's property if the individual is not engaged in the
- business of selling property as an auctioneer on a recurring basis;
- (4) $\left[\frac{(5)}{(5)}\right]$ a foreclosure sale of real property
- 18 personally conducted by a trustee under a deed of trust;
- (5) [(6)] a foreclosure sale of personal property
- 20 personally conducted by:
- 21 (A) a person who holds a security interest in the
- 22 property, including a mortgage; or
- 23 (B) an employee or agent of a person described by
- 24 Paragraph (A) acting in the course and scope of employment, if:
- 25 (i) the employee or agent is not otherwise
- 26 engaged in the auction business; and
- 27 (ii) all property for sale in the auction is

- 1 subject to a security agreement;
- 2 (6) [(7)] a sale conducted by sealed bid;
- 3 (7) $\left[\frac{(8)}{8}\right]$ an auction conducted only for student
- 4 training purposes as part of a course of study approved by the
- 5 department [executive director for auctioneers];
- (8) (8) (9) an auction conducted by a posted stockyard
- 7 or market agency as defined by the federal Packers and Stockyards
- 8 Act (7 U.S.C. Section 181 et seq.), as amended;
- 9 (9) $\left[\frac{(10)}{(10)}\right]$ an auction of livestock conducted by a
- 10 nonprofit livestock trade association chartered in this state, if
- 11 the auction involves only the sale of livestock owned by members of
- 12 the trade association; or
- (10) $[\frac{(11)}{}]$ an auction conducted by a charitable or
- 14 nonprofit organization chartered in this state, if the auction:
- 15 (A) is part of a fair that is organized under
- 16 state, county, or municipal authority; [and]
- 17 (B) involves only the sale of property owned by
- 18 the organization or owned or donated by the organization's members
- or supporters; or
- 20 (C) is performed on a nonrecurring basis.
- 21 SECTION 3. Subchapter B, Chapter 1802, Occupations Code, is
- amended by adding Section 1802.0515 to read as follows:
- Sec. 1802.0515. AUCTION COMPANIES; REQUIREMENTS. (a) An
- 24 auction company may not arrange, manage, sponsor, advertise,
- conduct, or offer to conduct auctions held in this state unless the
- 26 <u>auction company is owned or operated by an auctioneer licensed</u>
- 27 under this chapter.

- 1 (b) An auction company that advertises to conduct an auction
- 2 <u>in this state shall provide in the advertisement the name and</u>
- 3 license number of the auctioneer who owns the company, operates the
- 4 company, or is conducting the auction.
- 5 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
