H.B. No. 2175

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the creation of a judicial district composed of Fannin
3 County and to the composition of the 6th and 336th Judicial
4 Districts.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. The heading to Section 24.106, Government Code,
7 is amended to read as follows:

8 Sec. 24.106. 6TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (~~[FANNIN]~~ LAMAR~~[]~~ AND
9 RED RIVER COUNTIES).

10 SECTION 2. Section 24.106(a), Government Code, is amended
11 to read as follows:

12 (a) The 6th Judicial District is composed of ~~[Fannin]~~
13 Lamar~~[]~~ and Red River Counties ~~[counties]~~.

14 SECTION 3. The heading to Section 24.482, Government Code,
15 is amended to read as follows:

16 Sec. 24.482. 336TH JUDICIAL DISTRICT (~~[FANNIN AND]~~ GRAYSON
17 COUNTY ~~[COUNTIES]~~).

18 SECTION 4. Section 24.482(a), Government Code, is amended
19 to read as follows:

20 (a) The 336th Judicial District is composed of ~~[Fannin and]~~
21 Grayson County ~~[counties]~~.

22 SECTION 5. Subchapter C, Chapter 24, Government Code, is
23 amended by adding Section 24.576 to read as follows:

24 Sec. 24.576. 432ND JUDICIAL DISTRICT (FANNIN COUNTY). The

1 432nd Judicial District is composed of Fannin County.

2 SECTION 6. (a) The 432nd Judicial District is created on
3 the effective date of this Act.

4 (b) The local administrative district judge shall transfer
5 all cases from Fannin County that are pending in the 6th District
6 Court or the 336th District Court on the effective date of this Act
7 to the 432nd District Court.

8 (c) When a case is transferred from one court to another as
9 provided by Subsection (b) of this section, all processes, writs,
10 bonds, recognizances, or other obligations issued from the
11 transferring court are returnable to the court to which the case is
12 transferred, as if originally issued by that court. The obligees in
13 all bonds and recognizances taken in and for a court from which a
14 case is transferred, and all witnesses summoned to appear in a court
15 from which a case is transferred, are required to appear before the
16 court to which a case is transferred as if originally required to
17 appear before the court to which the transfer is made.

18 SECTION 7. This Act takes effect September 1, 2006.
