- 7 following persons may be donees of gifts of bodies or parts of

- 9 (1) a qualified organ procurement organization, for

- 12 (2) a hospital or physician, to be used only for

- 16 (4) a person specified by a physician, to be used only
- for therapy or transplantation needed by the person;

- 2 (7) [(6)] the Anatomical Board of the State of Texas.
- 3 Except for donations to a forensic science program under 4 Subsection (a)(6), the [The] Anatomical Board of the State of Texas shall be the donee of gifts of bodies or parts of bodies made for 5 education or research, which are subject to distribution by that 6 board under Chapter 691.
