- 1 (b) Notwithstanding any other law, a person who is entitled
 2 to pay resident tuition and fees only as permitted by this section
 3 is not considered a Texas resident under this subchapter for
 4 purposes of a financial aid program offered by this state.
- SECTION 2. Section 54.073, Education Code, as added by this
 Act, applies beginning with tuition and other fees charged for the
 2005 fall semester. Tuition and other fees charged for an academic
 period before the 2005 fall semester are covered by the law in
 effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the
 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
