5	SECTION 1. Section 203.003, Election Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	Sec. 203.003. [ <del>MAJORITY</del> ] VOTE REQUIRED. To be elected in a
8	special election for an unexpired term, a candidate must receive <u>:</u>
9	(1) a majority of the total number of votes received by
10	all candidates for the unexpired term <u>if the unexpired term is</u>
11	longer than one year; or
12	(2) a plurality of the total number of votes received
13	by all candidates for the unexpired term if the unexpired term is
14	one year or less.
15	SECTION 2. Section 203.004, Election Code, is amended by
16	adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
17	(c) For purposes of Subsection (a), the general primary
18	election date is considered a uniform election date. The secretary
19	of state shall adopt any necessary procedures to allow for the
20	holding of an election under this chapter on the general primary
21	election day.
22	SECTION 3. Section 203.005(b), Election Code, is amended to
23	read as follows:
24	(b) An application must, in addition to complying with

17	SECTION 5. The change in law made by this Act applies only
18	to a special election for a vacancy in the legislature that occurs
19	on or after the effective date of this Act.
20	SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
