5	SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 241, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 241.1531 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 241.1531. EXCHANGE OF INMATE'S HEALTH CARE
8	INFORMATION. Notwithstanding any other law of this state, the
9	health care information of a patient who is a defendant or inmate
10	confined in a facility operated by or under contract with the Texas
11	Department of Criminal Justice may be exchanged between health care
12	personnel of the department and health care personnel of The
13	University of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston or the Texas Tech
14	University Health Sciences Center. The authorization of the
15	defendant or inmate is not required for the exchange of
16	information.
17	SECTION 2. The change in law made by Section 241.1531,
18	Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, is intended to clarify
19	rather than change existing law.
20	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
21	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
22	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
23	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
24	Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
