## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the disclosure of certain confidential health
- 3 information to the Texas Department of Criminal Justice.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 241, Health and Safety
- 6 Code, is amended by adding Section 241.1531 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 241.1531. EXCHANGE OF INMATE'S HEALTH CARE
- 8 INFORMATION. Notwithstanding any other law of this state, the
- 9 health care information of a patient who is a defendant or inmate
- 10 confined in a facility operated by or under contract with the Texas
- 11 Department of Criminal Justice may be exchanged between health care
- 12 personnel of the department and health care personnel of The
- 13 University of Texas Medical Branch at Galveston or the Texas Tech
- 14 University Health Sciences Center. The authorization of the
- 15 <u>defendant or inmate</u> is not required for the exchange of
- 16 information.

- 17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by Section 241.1531,
- 18 Health and Safety Code, as added by this Act, is intended to clarify
- 19 rather than change existing law.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 22 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
