BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 1-13 1**-**14 1**-**15 SECTION 1. Section 54.535, Education Code, is amended to read as follows: 1-16 Sec. 54.535. STUDENT UNION FEE; THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS AT 1-17 EL PASO. (a) The board of regents of The University of Texas System may <u>impose</u> [levy] a student union fee not to exceed \$30 per student for each regular semester or each summer session of six weeks or 1-18 1-19 1-20 more, and not to exceed \$15 per student for each summer session of less than six weeks, for the sole purpose of financing, constructing, operating, maintaining, and improving a student 1-21 1-22 union building for The University of Texas at El Paso. The maximum 1-23 amount of the fee that may be charged per student for each regular semester or each summer session may be increased to an amount not to 1-24 1-25 exceed \$50 if that maximum amount is approved by a two-thirds vote 1-26 1-27 of those students participating in a general student election called at the university for that purpose. The election may be held 1-28 1-29 at the same time as an election under Subsection (b) to increase the 1-30 amount of the fee charged. - SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply beginning with fees imposed for the 2005 fall semester. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 2-7 2-8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 2-9 2-10 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
