- 8 VICTIM. (a) In this section, "elderly individual" has the meaning
- 9 assigned by Section 22.04.
- 10 (b) If it is shown on the trial of an offense under Chapter
- 11 32 that a victim of the offense is an elderly individual, the
- punishment for:

- 13 <u>(1) an offense otherwise punishable as a misdemeanor</u>
- is increased to the punishment for a state jail felony; and
- 15 (2) a felony other than a felony of the first degree is
- increased to the punishment prescribed for the next higher category
- of offense.
- 18 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 19 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 20 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
