- 5 SECTION 1. Section 554.003, Occupations Code, is amended to

- 9 (1) the licensing procedures to be followed, including

- 13 license.
- 14 (b) Not later than the 20th day after the date a license
- application is submitted to the board under this chapter, the board
- shall provide written notice to the applicant of any deficiency in
- 17 the applicant's qualifications or credentials related to obtaining
- 18 <u>a pharmacy license under this subtitle or with regard to a facility</u>
- 19 regulated under this subtitle.
- (c) The board shall place in the file of each applicant
- 21 applying for a pharmacy license written documentation of:
- (1) the investigation process conducted by the board

- 24 (2) all information regarding the applicant or related

- 1 to the applicant's application that is shared by the board with any
- 2 other state or federal agency; and
- 3 (3) any assistance with respect to the application
- 4 provided by a state or federal agency to the board as part of the
- 5 <u>application process.</u>
- 6 (d) On request by the applicant, the board shall provide to
- 7 the applicant, in a timely manner, a copy of the information placed
- 8 <u>in the applicant's file under Subsection (c) or as required by board</u>
- 9 <u>rule.</u>
- 10 SECTION 2. The Texas State Board of Pharmacy shall adopt the
- 11 rules and procedures required by Section 554.003, Occupations Code,
- 12 as amended by this Act, not later than January 1, 2006.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
