8	locksmith company for the purposes of this chapter if the person $:$

10	devices, including deadbolts and locks <u>;</u> [, and:]
11	(2) [(1)] advertises services offered by the company
12	using the term "locksmith"; or
13	(3) [(2)] includes the term "locksmith" in the
14	company's name.
15	SECTION 2. Section 1702.2227, Occupations Code, is amended
16	to read as follows:
17	Sec. 1702.2227. LOCKSMITH. An individual acts as a
18	locksmith for the purposes of this chapter if the person:
19	(1) sells, installs, or maintains mechanical security
20	devices, including deadbolts and locks <u>; or</u> [, and]
21	(2) advertises or offers services to the public or
22	represents to the public that the person is a locksmith.
23	SECTION 3. Subchapter L, Chapter 1702, Occupations Code, is
24	amended by adding Section 1702.286 to read as follows:

1	Sec. 1702.286. CUSTOMER AUTHORIZATION REQUIRED FOR CERTAIN
2	LOCKSMITH SERVICES. (a) A locksmith company or locksmith may not
3	perform services for a customer who seeks entry to a structure,
4	motor vehicle, or other property without first receiving a signed
5	authorization by the customer stating that the customer owns or is
6	otherwise entitled to legal access to the structure, motor vehicle,
7	or other property.
8	(b) A locksmith company or locksmith is exempt from
9	Subsection (a) if the locksmith is requested to perform services in
10	a case of imminent threat to a person or property.
11	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
