5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Subchapter Z, Chapter 214, Local Government
7	Code, is amended by adding Section 214.904 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 214.904. PROHIBITION OF CERTAIN MUNICIPAL
9	REQUIREMENTS REGARDING SALES OF HOUSING UNITS OR RESIDENTIAL LOTS.
10	(a) A municipality may not adopt a requirement in any form,
11	including through an ordinance or regulation or as a condition for
12	granting a building permit, that:
13	(1) has the effect of establishing a maximum sales
14	price for a housing unit or residential building lot; or
15	(2) requires a housing unit or residential building
16	lot to be designated for sale to any particular class or group of
17	purchasers defined by income or wealth.

- 18 <u>(b) This section does not affect any authority of a</u>
 19 municipality to create or implement an incentive, contract
- 20 commitment, density bonus, or other voluntary program designed to
- 21 <u>increase the supply of moderate or lower cost housing units.</u>
- 22 SECTION 2. A requirement of a municipality that violates
- 23 Section 214.904, Local Government Code, as added by this Act, is
- void on the effective date of this Act.

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1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
