- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 38.01(5), Penal Code, is amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 (5) "Fugitive from justice" means a person for whom a
- 8 valid arrest warrant, capias, commitment, attachment, or other
- 9 <u>instrument</u> has been issued <u>requiring a peace officer to take</u>
- 10 custody of the person.
- SECTION 2. Sections 38.02(a), (b), and (d), Penal Code, are
- 12 amended to read as follows:
- 13 (a) A person commits an offense if the person, on a request
- 14 for the information, knowingly [he intentionally] refuses to give
- 15 the person's [his] name, residence address, or date of birth to a
- 16 peace officer who has:
- 17 (1) lawfully arrested the person; or
- 18 (2) lawfully detained the person [and requested the
- 19 <u>information</u>].
- 20 (b) A person commits an offense if the person knowingly [he
- 21 intentionally gives a false or fictitious name, residence address,
- 22 or date of birth to a peace officer who has:
- 23 (1) lawfully arrested the person;
- 24 (2) lawfully detained the person; or

- 1 (3) requested the information from a person that the 2 peace officer has good cause to believe is a witness to a criminal
- 3 offense.
- 4 (d) If it is shown on the trial of an offense under this
- 5 section that the defendant was a fugitive from justice at the time
- 6 of the offense, the <u>punishment prescribed for the</u> offense is
- 7 increased to the punishment prescribed for the next highest
- 8 category of offense[+
- 9 [(1) a Class B misdemeanor if the offense is committed
- 10 under Subsection (a); or
- 11 [(2) a Class A misdemeanor if the offense is committed
- 12 under Subsection (b)].
- 13 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 14 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 15 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 16 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the
- former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 18 this section, an offense is committed before the effective date of
- 19 this Act if any element of the offense occurs before the effective
- 20 date.
- 21 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
