4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 54, Education Code, is

amended by adding Section 54.5441 to read as follows:

7 Sec. 54.5441. STUDENT RECREATIONAL AND HEALTH FACILITIES

8 FEE; MIDWESTERN STATE UNIVERSITY. (a) The board of regents of

Midwestern State University may charge each student enrolled at the

university a recreational and health facilities fee not to exceed

\$130 per semester or summer session of longer than six weeks or \$65

per summer session of six weeks or less. The fee may be used to

finance, construct, operate, renovate, or maintain recreational

and wellness facilities and programs at the university.

15 (b) The recreational and health facilities fee authorized

by this section may not be increased more than 10 percent from one

academic year to the next unless the increase has been approved by a

majority vote of those students participating in a general student

election called for that purpose. The fee may not exceed the

amounts provided by Subsection (a).

21 (c) The chief fiscal officer of the university shall collect

22 <u>any recreational and health facilities fee imposed under this</u>

23 section and shall deposit the money collected in an account to be

24 known as the student recreational and health facilities account.

- 1 (d) A recreational and health facilities fee imposed under
 2 this section is not counted in determining the maximum student
 3 services fee that may be charged under Section 54.503.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to fees imposed for a semester or term that begins on or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
