- 2 relating to an employment agreement that requires an employee to
- 3 waive the right to demand a jury trial.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subtitle A, Title 2, Labor Code, is amended by 6 adding Chapter 25 to read as follows:
- 7 CHAPTER 25. RESTRICTIONS ON EMPLOYMENT AGREEMENTS
- 8 Sec. 25.001. WAIVER OF RIGHT TO DEMAND JURY TRIAL
- 9 PROHIBITED. Notwithstanding any other law, an employment agreement
- 10 under which an employee is required to waive, as a condition of
- 11 employment, the employee's right to demand a jury trial is void and
- 12 against the public policy of this state unless the employment
- 13 <u>agreement provides for arbitration.</u>
- 14 SECTION 2. Chapter 25, Labor Code, as added by this Act,
- applies only to an employment agreement entered into on or after the
- 16 effective date of this Act. An employment agreement entered into
- 17 before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in
- 18 effect on the date the agreement was entered into, and the former
- 19 law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
