## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the dissemination of accurate information on voluntary
3	and informed consent for an abortion.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 171.012(a), Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended to read as follows:
7	(a) Except in the case of a medical emergency, consent to an
8	abortion is voluntary and informed only if:
9	(1) the physician who is to perform the abortion or the
10	referring physician informs the woman on whom the abortion is to be
11	performed of:
12	(A) the name of the physician who will perform
13	the abortion;
14	(B) the particular medical risks associated with
15	the particular abortion procedure to be employed, including, when
16	medically accurate:
17	(i) the risks of infection and hemorrhage;
18	<u>and</u>
19	(ii) the potential danger to a subsequent
20	pregnancy and of infertility; [and
21	[(iii) the possibility of increased risk of
22	breast cancer following an induced abortion and the natural

cancer;

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23 protective effect of a completed pregnancy in avoiding breast

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- 1 (C) the probable gestational age of the unborn
- 2 child at the time the abortion is to be performed; and
- 3 (D) the medical risks associated with carrying
- 4 the child to term;
- 5 (2) the physician who is to perform the abortion or the
- 6 physician's agent informs the woman that:
- 7 (A) medical assistance benefits may be available
- 8 for prenatal care, childbirth, and neonatal care;
- 9 (B) the father is liable for assistance in the
- 10 support of the child without regard to whether the father has
- 11 offered to pay for the abortion;
- 12 (C) public and private agencies provide
- 13 pregnancy prevention counseling and medical referrals for
- 14 obtaining pregnancy prevention medications or devices, including
- emergency contraception for victims of rape or incest; and
- 16 (D) the woman has the right to review the printed
- 17 materials described by Section 171.014, that those materials have
- 18 been provided by the [<del>Texas</del>] Department of State Health Services
- 19 and are accessible on an Internet website sponsored by the
- 20 department, and that the materials describe the unborn child and
- 21 list agencies that offer alternatives to abortion;
- 22 (3) the woman certifies in writing before the abortion
- is performed that the information described by Subdivisions (1) and
- 24 (2) has been provided to her and that she has been informed of her
- opportunity to review the information described by Section 171.014;
- 26 and
- 27 (4) before the abortion is performed, the physician

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- 1 who is to perform the abortion receives a copy of the written
- 2 certification required by Subdivision (3).
- 3 SECTION 2. (a) By not later than December 1, 2005, the
- 4 Department of State Health Services shall:
- 5 (1) revise the informational materials the department
- 6 is required to publish under Section 171.014, Health and Safety
- 7 Code; and
- 8 (2) make the materials available for distribution.
- 9 (b) The changes in law made by this Act apply only to the
- 10 abortion information a physician is required to provide under
- 11 Section 171.012, Health and Safety Code, on or after January 1,
- 12 2006.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
