A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the venue for certain crimes regarding misapplication 3 of property. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Chapter 13, Code of Criminal Procedure, is 6 amended by adding Article 13.30 to read as follows: Art. 13.30. MISAPPLICATION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY. (a) 7 An offender who misapplies property held as a fiduciary or property of 8 9 a financial institution in one county and removes the property to another county may be prosecuted in either the county where the 10 11 offender misapplied the property or in any other county through or 12 into which the offender removed the property. 13 (b) An offense related to misapplication of construction 14 trust funds under Chapter 162, Property Code, must be prosecuted in the county where the construction project is located. 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 16 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 17 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 18 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the 19 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of 20 21 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that 22 23 date. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005. 24
