5 SECTION 1. Section 12.44(b), Penal Code, is amended to read

6 as follows:

- 7 (b) At the request of the prosecuting attorney [When a court
- 8 is authorized to impose punishment for a lesser category of offense

9 as provided in Subsection (a)], the court may authorize the

prosecuting attorney to prosecute a state jail felony as a Class A

- 11 misdemeanor [initially for the lesser category of offense].
- 12 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 14 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
- 15 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the
- 16 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of
- 17 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of
- 18 this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that
- 19 date.
