The change in law made by this Act applies only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act. 13 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is 14 covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed, and the 15 former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For purposes of 16 this section, an offense was committed before the effective date of 17 this Act if any element of the offense was committed before that 18 19 date.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
