A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1-11 relating to the terms of office of the Product Development and Small  
1-12 Business Incubator Board.

1-13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-14 SECTION 1. Subsection (c), Section 489.203, Government  
1-15 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-16 (c) Appointed members of the board serve six-year  
1-17 [~~two-year~~] staggered terms, with the terms of three members  
1-18 expiring February 1 of each odd-numbered year.

1-19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-23 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
