4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 262.303, Family Code, is amended by
6	adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
7	(c) The department may not attempt to ascertain the identity
8	of or locate the parent who voluntarily delivered the child to the
9	designated emergency infant care provider, unless it appears that
10	the child has been abused or neglected.
11	SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 262, Family Code, is
12	amended by adding Sections 262.308 and 262.309 to read as follows:
13	Sec. 262.308. CONFIDENTIALITY. (a) All identifying
14	information, documentation, or other records regarding a person who
15	voluntarily delivers a child to a designated emergency infant care
16	provider under this subchapter is confidential and not subject to
17	release to any individual or entity except as provided by
18	Subsection (b).
19	(b) Any pleading or other document filed with a court under
20	this subchapter is confidential, is not public information for
21	purposes of Chapter 552, Government Code, and may not be released to
22	a person other than to a party in a suit regarding the child, the
23	party's attorney, or an attorney ad litem or guardian ad litem
24	appointed in the suit.

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1 (c) In a suit concerning a child for whom the Department of 2 Family and Protective Services assumes care, control, and custody under this subchapter, the court shall close the hearing to the 3 public unless the court finds that the interests of the child or the 4 5 public would be better served by opening the hearing to the public. 6 (d) Unless the disclosure, receipt, or use is permitted by 7 this section, a person commits an offense if the person knowingly discloses, receives, uses, or permits the use of information 8 derived from records or files described by this section or 9 knowingly discloses identifying information concerning a person 10 who voluntarily delivers a child to a designated emergency infant 11 care provider. An offense under this subsection is a Class B 12 13 misdemeanor. 14 Sec. 262.309. SEARCH FOR RELATIVES NOT REQUIRED. The 15 Department of Family and Protective Services is not required to conduct a search for the relatives of a child for whom the 16 17 department assumes care, control, and custody under this 18 subchapter. SECTION 3. Section 263.3025(d), Family Code, is repealed. 19 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies to a 20 21 child for whom the Department of Family and Protective Services assumes responsibility under Subchapter D, Chapter 262, Family 22 Code, as amended by this Act, regardless of whether the department 23 24 assumed responsibility for the child before, on, or after the effective date of this Act. 25 26

SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.

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
