5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. The heading to Section 502.1715, Transportation
7	Code, is amended to read as follows:
8	Sec. 502.1715. ADDITIONAL FEE FOR <u>CERTAIN DEPARTMENT</u>
9	PROGRAMS [MOTOR VEHICLE FINANCIAL RESPONSIBILITY VERIFICATION
10	PROGRAM].
11	SECTION 2. Sections 502.1715(b) and (c), Transportation
12	Code, are amended to read as follows:
13	(b) <u>Fees</u> [ <del>Before August 31, 2005, fees</del> ] collected under this
14	section shall be deposited to the credit of the state highway fund.
15	Subject to appropriations, the money shall be used by the
16	Department of Public Safety to:
17	(1) support the Department of Public Safety's
18	reengineering of the driver's license system to provide for the
19	issuance by the Department of Public Safety of a driver's license or
20	personal identification certificate, [not] to include use of <u>image</u>
21	<pre>comparison technology [biometric information];</pre>
22	(2) establish and maintain a system to support the
23	driver responsibility program under Chapter 708; and
24	(3) [ <del>conduct the feasibility study authorized by</del>

1	Section 601.450; and
2	[ <del>(4)</del> ] make lease payments to the master lease purchase
3	program for the financing of [+
4	[ <del>(A)</del> ] the driver's license reengineering project
5	[ <del>; and</del>
6	[(B) the liability insurance feasibility study].
7	(c) <u>Fees</u> [ <del>On or after August 31, 2005, fees</del> ] collected under
8	this section shall be deposited to the credit of the state highway
9	fund. Subject to appropriation, the money may be used by the
10	Department of Public Safety, the Texas Department of Insurance, and
11	the department to carry out Subchapter N, Chapter 601.
12	SECTION 3. Section 521.001(a), Transportation Code, is
13	amended by adding Subdivision (9) to read as follows:
14	(9) "Image comparison technology" means any
15	technology that is used to compare facial images, thumbprints, or
16	fingerprints.
17	SECTION 4. Subchapter C, Chapter 521, Transportation Code,
18	is amended by adding Section 521.059 to read as follows:
19	Sec. 521.059. IMAGE VERIFICATION SYSTEM. (a) The
20	department shall establish an image verification system based on
21	the following identifiers collected by the department:
22	(1) an applicant's facial image; and
23	(2) an applicant's thumbprints or fingerprints.
24	(b) The department shall authenticate the facial image and
25	thumbprints or fingerprints provided by an applicant for a personal
26	identification certificate, driver's license, or commercial
27	driver's license or permit using image comparison technology to

1	ensure that the applicant:
2	(1) is issued only one original license, permit, or
3	<pre>certificate;</pre>
4	(2) does not fraudulently obtain a duplicate license,
5	permit, or certificate; and
6	(3) does not commit other fraud in connection with the
7	application for a license, permit, or certificate.
8	(c) The department shall use the image verification system
9	established under this section only to the extent allowed by
10	Chapter 730, Transportation Code, to aid other law enforcement
11	agencies in:
12	(1) establishing the identity of a victim of a
13	disaster or crime that a local law enforcement agency is unable to
14	establish; or
15	(2) conducting an investigation of criminal conduct.
16	(d) The department shall provide a statistical report
17	annually to the legislature describing the rate of error presented
18	in the image verification system, including the rate of incorrect
19	matching of facial images, categorized by race. This subsection
20	expires September 1, 2010.
21	SECTION 5. Section 521.142(b), Transportation Code, is
22	amended to read as follows:
23	(b) The application must include:
24	(1) the thumbprints of the applicant or, if
25	thumbprints cannot be taken, the index fingerprints of the
26	applicant; [ <del>and</del> ]
27	(2) <u>a photograph of the applicant;</u>

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1	(3) the signature of the applicant; and
2	(4) a brief description of the applicant.
3	SECTION 6. Section 730.010, Transportation Code, is amended
4	to read as follows:
5	Sec. 730.010. DISCLOSURE OF THUMB OR FINGER IMAGES
6	PROHIBITED. Notwithstanding any other provision of this chapter,
7	if an agency obtains an image of an individual's thumb or finger in
8	connection with the issuance of a license, permit, or certificate
9	to the individual, the agency may:
10	(1) use the image only <u>:</u>
11	(A) in connection with the issuance of the
12	license, permit, or certificate; <u>or</u>
13	(B) to verify the identity of an individual as
14	provided by Section 521.059; and
15	(2) disclose the image only if disclosure is expressly
16	authorized by law.
17	SECTION 7. The amendments to Section 502.1715,
18	Transportation Code, by this Act prevail over any other Act of the
19	79th Legislature, Regular Session, 2005, regardless of the relative
20	dates of enactment.
21	SECTION 8. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
22	a driver's license or permit, or personal identification
23	certificate, or the renewal of a driver's license or permit, or
24	certificate, applied for on or after the effective date of this Act.
25	A driver's license or permit, or personal identification
26	certificate, or the renewal of a driver's license or permit, or
27	certificate, applied for before the effective date of this Act is

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1 covered by the law in effect on the date the application was made,
2 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
3 SECTION 9. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
