8 (2) disclose the image only if disclosure is expressly9 authorized by law.

SECTION 7. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to 10 driver's license or permit, or personal identification 11 a certificate, or the renewal of a driver's license or permit, or 12 certificate, applied for on or after the effective date of this Act. 13 14 A driver's license or permit, or personal identification 15 certificate, or the renewal of a driver's license or permit, or certificate, applied for before the effective date of this Act is 16 17 covered by the law in effect on the date the application was made, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. 18

19 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
