4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 813.301, Government Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	Sec. 813.301. CREDITABLE MILITARY SERVICE. (a) Military
8	service creditable in the retirement system is:
9	(1) active federal duty as a member of the armed forces
10	of the United States <u>;</u>
11	(2) service as a member of the Texas National Guard; or
12	(3) service in any of the reserve components of the
13	armed forces of the United States.
14	(b) A member may establish [one month of service credit for
15	each month or fraction of a month of duty, but] not more than 60
16	months of service credit in the retirement system for military
17	service.
18	(c) Service is creditable under this section for active
19	federal duty as a member of the armed forces of the United States at
20	the rate of one month of service credit for each month or fraction
21	of a month of that service. Service is creditable under this
22	section for service as a member of the Texas National Guard or for
23	service in any of the reserve components of the armed forces of the
24	United States at the rate of one month of service credit for each

1	three months or fractions of months of that service.
2	SECTION 2. Section 813.302(b), Government Code, is amended
3	to read as follows:
4	(b) A member eligible to establish military service credit
5	is one who:
6	(1) does not receive and is not eligible to receive
7	federal retirement payments based on 20 years or more of active
8	federal military duty or its equivalent;
9	(2) has been released from military duty under
10	honorable conditions [not dishonorable]; and
11	(3) has credit in the retirement system for membership
12	service performed after the member's date of release from active
13	military duty.
14	SECTION 3. Section 813.505(b), Government Code, is amended
15	to read as follows:
16	(b) A member claiming credit in the employee class for
17	military service not previously established shall, for each month
18	of the <u>creditable</u> service, pay a contribution in an amount equal to
19	the greater of:
20	(1) the amount that the member contributed for the
21	first full month of membership service that is after the member's
22	date of release from military service described by Section
23	813.301(a) [active military duty] and that is credited in the
24	retirement system; or
25	(2) \$18.
26	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
27	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
