- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 843, Insurance Code, is 6 amended by adding Section 843.3046 to read as follows:
- Sec. 843.3046. ACUPUNCTURE. (a) If a health maintenance 7 organization offers acupuncture as a covered service, then it may 8 9 not refuse to pay for acupuncture services solely because the
- service was provided by an acupuncturist. 10
- (b) Nothing <u>in this Subchapter requires a health</u> 11 12 maintenance organization to offer acupuncture as a covered service.
- 13 SECTION 2. Subchapter 1301, Insurance Code, as effective
- 14 April 1, 2005, is amended by adding Section 1301.0523 to read as
- follows: 15

- Sec. 1301.0523. ACUPUNCTURE. (a) If an insurer offering a 16
- preferred provider benefit plan offers acupuncture as a covered 17
- 18 service, then it may not refuse to pay for acupuncture services
- solely because the service was provided by an acupuncturist. 19
- (b) Nothing in this Subchapter requires an insurer offering 20
- 21 a preferred provider benefit plan to offer acupuncture as a covered
- 22 service.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005. 23
