## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the administration of the child care program for
- 3 children of state employees.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Sections 663.001(2) and (3), Government Code,
- 6 are amended to read as follows:
- 7 (2) "Child care program" means the program developed
- 8 or administered under this chapter [by the commission] to provide
- 9 child care services for state employees.
- 10 (3) "Commission" means the Texas Building and
- 11 Procurement [General Services] Commission.
- 12 SECTION 2. Section 663.101, Government Code, is amended to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 Sec. 663.101. ADMINISTRATION OF CHILD CARE PROGRAM. (a)
- 15 The commission shall provide child care services for state
- 16 employees by the development [and administration] of the child care
- 17 program.
- 18 (b) The commission by rule may establish methods to
- 19 [administer and] supervise the entity operating the child care
- 20 program.
- 21 SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 663, Government Code, is
- 22 amended by adding Sections 663.1011 and 663.1012 to read as
- 23 follows:
- Sec. 663.1011. MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING. (a) The

- 1 commission may enter into a memorandum of understanding with The
- 2 University of Texas at Austin to operate the child care program.
- 3 (b) The memorandum of understanding must include the
- 4 responsibilities of the commission and the university regarding the
- 5 operation of the child care program, including:
- 6 (1) developing the curriculum for the child care
- 7 program;
- 8 (2) designating the location of child care facilities;
- 9 (3) providing and maintaining the buildings and other
- 10 property where the child care facilities are located;
- 11 (4) determining the size of the child care facilities
- and the child-to-teacher ratio for each age group at the facility;
- 13 and
- 14 (5) performing the duties described by Section
- 15 663.108.
- Sec. 663.1012. CONTRACT WITH ENTITY. (a) If the commission
- 17 does not enter into a memorandum of understanding with The
- 18 University of Texas at Austin to operate the child care program
- 19 under Section 663.1011, the commission shall contract with a
- 20 private or public entity to operate the child care program.
- 21 (b) Before the commission issues a request for proposal for
- 22 bids to operate the child care program, the commission shall
- 23 develop the request for proposal with the assistance of The
- 24 University of Texas at Austin.
- 25 SECTION 4. Section 663.102, Government Code, is amended to
- 26 read as follows:
- Sec. 663.102. STANDARDS OF CHILD CARE PROGRAM. The

- 1 commission shall, in consultation with The University of Texas at
- 2 Austin, set specific performance standards for child care services
- 3 under the child care program that conform to the standards of
- 4 quality child care set by the National Association for the
- 5 Education of Young Children or the National Child Care Association.
- 6 SECTION 5. Section 663.106, Government Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 663.106. LEASE TO CHILD CARE PROVIDER. The commission
- 9  $\underline{\text{may}}$  [shall] lease to a child care provider selected by the
- 10 commission a site for a child care facility at a reasonable rate.
- 11 SECTION 6. Section 663.108, Government Code, is amended to
- 12 read as follows:
- Sec. 663.108. DUTIES OF <u>ENTITY OPERATING</u> CHILD CARE <u>PROGRAM</u>
- 14 [PROVIDER]. The entity operating the [A provider for a] child care
- 15 program [facility] shall:
- 16 (1) obtain for <u>each child care</u> [the] facility a
- 17 license under Chapter 42, Human Resources Code;
- 18 (2) maintain liability insurance coverage by an
- 19 <u>insurer</u> [insurance company] approved by the Texas Department [State
- 20 Board of Insurance in an amount approved by the commission;
- 21 (3) indemnify the state and the commission from:
- 22 (A) a claim, demand, or cause of action asserted
- 23 by a person as a result of the <a href="child-care">child-care</a> facility's operation; and
- 24 (B) an act or omission of the provider or the
- 25 child care facility's personnel;
- 26 (4) provide furniture, equipment, toys, or other
- 27 materials necessary for the <u>child care</u> facility;

- 1 (5) keep a list of child care applicants who are
- 2 waiting for enrollment in the child care facility; and
- 3 (6) pay salaries and provide insurance for <u>persons</u>
- 4 <u>employed at</u> the <u>child care</u> [employees of the] facility.
- 5 SECTION 7. Section 663.109, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 663.109. MONITORING OF CHILD CARE <u>PROGRAM</u>
- 8 [FACILITIES]. The commission shall monitor the activities and
- 9 operations of the entity operating the child care program [a child
- 10 care facility by conducting regular visits to the facility during
- 11 operating hours to investigate, inspect, and evaluate the services
- 12 provided].
- SECTION 8. Section 663.111(a), Government Code, is amended
- 14 to read as follows:
- 15 (a) The commission shall monitor the number of children
- 16 participating in the child care program and determine, in
- 17 consultation with the entity operating the child care program, when
- 18 <u>additional child care facilities are needed</u> [may begin procedures
- 19 to establish another child care facility when the number of
- 20 applicants on a waiting list to enroll in a facility is 50 or more].
- 21 SECTION 9. The heading to Section 663.112, Government Code,
- 22 is amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 663.112. CHILD CARE PROGRAM [FACILITY] ACCOUNT.
- SECTION 10. Section 663.112(a), Government Code, is amended
- 25 to read as follows:
- 26 (a) The legislature may appropriate money from the Texas
- 27 capital trust fund established under Chapter 2201 to establish and

- operate the [a] child care program [facility under this chapter].
- 2 SECTION 11. Section 663.052, Government Code, is
- 3 redesignated as Section 663.114, Government Code, to read as
- 4 follows:
- Sec. 663.114 [663.052]. REPORT OF COMMISSION. (a) The
- 6 commission shall report to the legislature each legislative
- 7 session.
- 8 (b) The report must:
- 9 (1) summarize the development and progress of the
- 10 child care program; and
- 11 (2) describe additional child care services needed by
- 12 state employees.
- 13 SECTION 12. Sections 663.001(4), 663.002, 663.051,
- 14 663.104, 663.107, 663.111(b), 2165.103, and 2166.551, Government
- 15 Code, are repealed.
- 16 SECTION 13. This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 17 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 18 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 19 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 20 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
