- 2 relating to posting on the Internet the notice of a meeting of the
- 3 governing body of a county and certain districts and political
- 4 subdivisions.
- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 551.043, Government Code, is amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 551.043. TIME AND ACCESSIBILITY OF NOTICE; GENERAL
- 9 RULE. (a) The notice of a meeting of a governmental body must be
- 10 posted in a place readily accessible to the general public at all
- 11 times for at least 72 hours before the scheduled time of the
- meeting, except as provided by Sections 551.044-551.046.
- (b) If this chapter specifically requires or allows a
- 14 governmental body to post notice of a meeting on the Internet, the
- 15 governmental body satisfies the requirement that the notice must be
- 16 posted in a place readily accessible to the general public at all
- times by continuously posting the notice on the Internet during the
- 18 <u>prescribed period.</u>
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 551.049, Government Code, is amended to
- 20 read as follows:
- Sec. 551.049. COUNTY GOVERNMENTAL BODY: PLACE OF POSTING
- 22 NOTICE. A county governmental body:
- 23 (1) shall post notice of each meeting on a bulletin
- 24 board at a place convenient to the public in the county courthouse;

- 2 (2) may post notice of each meeting on the county's
- 3 <u>official Internet website</u>.
- 4 SECTION 3. Section 551.053, Government Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 551.053. DISTRICT OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION EXTENDING
- 7 INTO FOUR OR MORE COUNTIES: NOTICE TO PUBLIC, SECRETARY OF STATE,
- 8 AND COUNTY CLERK; PLACE OF POSTING NOTICE. (a) The governing body
- 9 of a water district or other district or political subdivision that
- 10 extends into four or more counties [shall]:
- 11 (1) <u>shall</u> post notice of each meeting at a place
- 12 convenient to the public in the administrative office of the
- 13 district or political subdivision;
- 14 (2) may post notice of each meeting on the official
- 15 Internet website of the district or political subdivision;
- 16 <u>(3) shall</u> provide notice of each meeting to the
- 17 secretary of state; and
- 18 $\underline{(4)}$ shall $\underline{(3)}$ provide notice of each meeting to the
- 19 county clerk of the county in which the administrative office of the
- 20 district or political subdivision is located.
- 21 (b) The secretary of state shall post the notice provided
- under Subsection (a)(3) $[\frac{(a)(2)}{2}]$ on the Internet. The secretary of
- 23 state shall provide during regular office hours a computer terminal
- 24 at a place convenient to the public in the office of the secretary
- of state that members of the public may use to view the notice.
- 26 (c) A county clerk:
- 27 (1) shall post the notice provided under Subsection

- 1 (a)(4) [(a)(3)] on a bulletin board at a place convenient to the
- public in the county courthouse; and
- 3 (2) may post each notice provided under Subsection
- 4 (a)(4) on the county's official Internet website.
- 5 SECTION 4. Section 551.054, Government Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 551.054. DISTRICT OR POLITICAL SUBDIVISION EXTENDING
- 8 INTO FEWER THAN FOUR COUNTIES: NOTICE TO PUBLIC AND COUNTY CLERKS;
- 9 PLACE OF POSTING NOTICE. (a) The governing body of a water
- 10 district or other district or political subdivision that extends
- into fewer than four counties [shall]:
- 12 (1) shall post notice of each meeting at a place
- 13 convenient to the public in the administrative office of the
- 14 district or political subdivision;
- 15 (2) may post notice of each meeting on the official
- 16 Internet website of the district or political subdivision; and
- 17 (3) shall $\left[\frac{(2)}{(2)}\right]$ provide notice of each meeting to the
- 18 county clerk of each county in which the district or political
- 19 subdivision is located.
- 20 (b) A county clerk:
- 21 <u>(1)</u> shall post the notice provided under Subsection
- (a)(3) $[\frac{(a)(2)}{(a)}]$ on a bulletin board at a place convenient to the
- 23 public in the county courthouse; and
- 24 (2) may post each notice provided under Subsection
- 25 (a)(3) on the county's official Internet website.
- 26 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
