H.B. No. 2384

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the composition of the Advisory Committee to the Texas  
3 Board of Criminal Justice on Offenders with Medical or Mental  
4 Impairments.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 614.002(e), Health and Safety Code, is  
7 amended to read as follows:

8 (e) The executive head of each of the following agencies,  
9 divisions of agencies, or associations, or that person's designated  
10 representative, shall serve as a member of the committee:

11 (1) the institutional division of the Texas Department  
12 of Criminal Justice;

13 (2) the Department of State Health Services [~~Texas~~  
14 ~~Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation~~];

15 (3) the pardons and paroles division of the Texas  
16 Department of Criminal Justice;

19 (5) the state jail division of the Texas Department of  
20 Criminal Justice;

21 (6) the Texas Juvenile Probation Commission;

22 (7) the Texas Youth Commission;

23 (8) the Department of Assistive and Rehabilitative  
24 Services [~~Texas Rehabilitation Commission~~];

- 1           (9) the Texas Education Agency;
- 2           (10) the Correctional Managed Health Care Committee  
3 ~~[Criminal Justice Policy Council]~~;
- 4           (11) the Mental Health Association in Texas;
- 5           (12) the Board of Pardons and Paroles [~~Texas~~  
6 ~~Commission on Alcohol and Drug Abuse~~];
- 7           (13) the Commission on Law Enforcement Officer  
8 Standards and Education;
- 9           (14) the Texas Council of Community Mental Health and  
10 Mental Retardation Centers;
- 11           (15) the Commission on Jail Standards;
- 12           (16) the Texas Council for Developmental  
13 Disabilities;
- 14           (17) the Texas Association for Retarded Citizens;
- 15           (18) the National [~~Texas~~] Alliance for the Mentally  
16 Ill of Texas;
- 17           (19) the Parent Association for the Retarded of Texas,  
18 Inc.;
- 19           (20) the Health and Human Services Commission [~~Texas~~  
20 ~~Department of Human Services~~]; and
- 21           (21) the Department of Aging and Disability Services  
22 [~~Texas Department on Aging~~].

23           SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
