A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

2 relating to the composition of the Advisory Committee to the Texas
3 Board of Criminal Justice on Offenders with Medical or Mental
4 Impairments.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

6 SECTION 1. Section 614.002(a), Health and Safety Code, as
7 amended by Chapters 856 and 1170, Acts of the 78th Legislature,
8 Regular Session, 2003, is reenacted and amended to read as follows:

9 (a) The Advisory Committee to the Texas Board of Criminal
10 Justice on Offenders with Medical or Mental Impairments is composed
11 of 32 [~~31~~] members.

12 SECTION 2. Section 614.002(e), Health and Safety Code, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 (e) The executive head of each of the following agencies,
15 divisions of agencies, or associations, or that person's designated
16 representative, shall serve as a member of the committee:

17 (1) the institutional division of the Texas Department
18 of Criminal Justice;

- 7 (9) the Texas Education Agency;
- 8 (10) the Criminal Justice Policy Council;
- 9 (11) the Mental Health Association in Texas;
- 10 (12) the Board of Pardons and Paroles [~~Texas~~
11 ~~Commission on Alcohol and Drug Abuse~~];
- 12 (13) the Commission on Law Enforcement Officer
13 Standards and Education;
- 14 (14) the Texas Council of Community Mental Health and
15 Mental Retardation Centers;
- 16 (15) the Commission on Jail Standards;
- 17 (16) the Texas Council for Developmental
18 Disabilities;
- 19 (17) the Texas Association for Retarded Citizens;
- 20 (18) the Texas Alliance for the Mentally Ill;
- 21 (19) the Parent Association for the Retarded of Texas,
22 Inc.;
- 23 (20) the Health and Human Services Commission [~~Texas~~
24 ~~Department of Human Services~~]; ~~and~~
- 25 (21) the Department of Aging and Disability Services

- 27 (22) the Correctional Managed Health Care Committee.

1 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
