1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Section 614.002(e), Health and Safety Code, is
1-13 amended to read as follows:

1-14 (e) The executive head of each of the following agencies,
1-15 divisions of agencies, or associations, or that person's designated
1-16 representative, shall serve as a member of the committee:
