- 9 (f) A person who has not made an application as provided by
- 10 this title is not entitled to receive an early voting ballot to be
- 11 voted by mail. A marked ballot voted by mail of a person who has not
- 12 made an application as provided by this title may not be counted.
- 13 (g) A person commits an offense if, with the intent that an
- 14 unlawful ballot be cast, the person directs the return of a marked
- early voting ballot by mail as provided by Section 86.006 with the
- 16 knowledge that the ballot is from a voter who is not entitled to
- 17 receive an early voting ballot to be voted by mail. An offense
- under this subsection is a Class C misdemeanor.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 86.002, Election Code, is amended by
- 20 adding Subsection (h) to read as follows:
- 21 (h) The clerk shall include with the balloting materials a
- 22 notice in a form prescribed by the secretary of state:
- 23 (1) informing the voter of the categories of persons
- 24 who are eligible to vote by mail; and

- 1 (2) stating that the voter should not cast the ballot
- 2 unless the voter or a person authorized by this code to assist the
- 3 voter requested the ballot.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act applies only to an election ordered on
- or after the effective date of this Act.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
