- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 84.001, Election Code, is amended by
- 7 amending Subsection (f) and adding Subsection (g) to read as
- 8 follows:
- 9 (f) A person who has not made an application as provided by
- 10 this title is not entitled to receive an early voting ballot to be
- 11 voted by mail. A marked ballot voted by mail of a person who has not
- made an application as provided by this title may not be counted.
- 13 (g) A person commits an offense if the person votes a ballot
- 14 by mail with knowledge that the person is not entitled to receive an
- 15 <u>early voting ballot to be voted by mail</u>. An offense under this
- subsection is a Class A misdemeanor.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to an election ordered on
- 18 or after the effective date of this Act.
- 19 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
