A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to delivery to an employer of an order or writ for the 3 withholding of child support from an employee's earnings.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 158.105, Family Code, is amended by 6 amending Subsections (b) and (c) and adding Subsection (d) to read
- 7 as follows:
- 8 (b) The clerk shall issue and $\underline{\text{deliver}}$ [$\underline{\text{mail}}$] the certified
- 9 copy of the order or judicial writ not later than the fourth working
- 10 day after the date the order is signed or the request is filed,
- 11 whichever is later.
- 12 (c) An order or judicial writ of withholding shall be
- delivered to the employer by first class mail or, if requested, by
- 14 certified or registered mail, return receipt requested, by
- 15 electronic transmission, including electronic mail or facsimile
- 16 transmission, or by service of citation to:
- 17 (1) the person authorized to receive service of
- 18 process for the employer in civil cases generally; or
- 19 (2) a person designated by the employer, by written
- 20 notice to the clerk, to receive orders or writs of withholding.
- 21 (d) The clerk may deliver an order or judicial writ of
- 22 withholding under Subsection (c) by electronic mail if the employer
- 23 has an electronic mail address or by facsimile transmission if the
- 24 employer is capable of receiving documents transmitted in that

- 1 manner. If delivery is accomplished by electronic mail, the clerk
- 2 must request acknowledgment of receipt from the employer or use an
- 3 electronic mail system with a read receipt capability. If delivery
- 4 <u>is accomplished by facsimile transmission</u>, the clerk's facsimile
- 5 machine must create a delivery confirmation report.
- 6 SECTION 2. Section 158.105, Family Code, as amended by this
- 7 Act, applies only to an order or judicial writ of withholding
- 8 delivered to an employer on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 9 An order or judicial writ of withholding delivered before the
- 10 effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the
- 11 date the order or writ was delivered, and the former law is
- 12 continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
