1-8 AN ACT

1-9 relating to the designation of Farm-to-Market Road 2065 as the  
1-10 Staff Sergeant Herbert S. Robertson, Jr., Memorial Highway.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 225, Transportation Code,  
1-13 is amended by adding Section 225.059 to read as follows:

1-14 Sec. 225.059. STAFF SERGEANT HERBERT S. ROBERTSON, JR.,  
1-15 MEMORIAL HIGHWAY. (a) Farm-to-Market Road 2065 from its  
1-16 intersection with State Highway 77 to its intersection with County  
1-17 Road 2466 is designated as the Staff Sergeant Herbert S. Robertson,  
1-18 Jr., Memorial Highway.

1-19 (b) The department shall design and construct memorial  
1-20 markers indicating the highway number, the designation as the Staff  
1-21 Sergeant Herbert S. Robertson, Jr., Memorial Highway, and any other  
1-22 appropriate information.

1-23 (c) Except as provided by Subsection (d), the department  
1-24 shall erect a marker at each end of the highway and at appropriate  
1-25 intermediate sites along the highway.

1-26 (d) The department is not required to design, construct, or  
1-27 erect a marker under this section unless a grant or donation of  
1-28 private funds is made to the department to cover the cost of the  
1-29 design, construction, and erection of the marker.

1-30 (e) Money received under Subsection (d) shall be deposited  
1-31 to the credit of the state highway fund.

1-32 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
