2	relating to water and energy saving performance standards for
3	commercial prerinse spray valves.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 372.001, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by adding Subdivision (5) to read as follows:
7	(5) "Commercial prerinse spray valve" means a handheld
8	device that is designed and marketed for use with commercial
9	dishwashing and ware washing equipment and that is used to spray
10	water on dishes, flatware, and other food service items to remove
11	food residue before the items are cleaned in a dishwasher or ware
12	washer or by hand.
13	SECTION 2. Chapter 372, Health and Safety Code, is amended
14	by adding Section 372.005 to read as follows:
15	Sec. 372.005. COMMERCIAL PRERINSE SPRAY VALVE PERFORMANCE
16	STANDARDS. (a) A person may not sell, offer for sale, distribute,
17	lease, or import into this state a commercial prerinse spray valve
18	for use in this state unless the prerinse spray valve:
19	(1) has a flow rate of 1.6 gallons of water per minute
20	or less, as determined using the standard test method for prerinse
21	spray valves developed by the American Society for Testing and
22	Materials as specified in ASTM F2324-03 as that method existed on
23	January 1, 2006; and
24	(2) is listed by the commission under Subsection (b).

(b) The commission shall make and maintain a current list of 1 2 commercial prerinse spray valves that are certified to the commission by the manufacturer or importer to meet the performance 3 4 standards provided by Subsection (a)(1). To have a commercial prerinse spray valve included on the list, the manufacturer or 5 6 importer must supply to the commission, in the form prescribed by the commission, the identification and the performance 7 specifications of the prerinse spray valve. The commission may 8 9 test a listed commercial prerinse spray valve to determine the accuracy of the manufacturer's or importer's certification and 10 shall remove from the list a prerinse spray valve the commission 11 12 determines to be inaccurately certified.

(c) The commission may assess against a manufacturer or an 13 importer a reasonable fee for an inspection of a commercial 14 15 prerinse spray valve to determine the accuracy of the manufacturer's or importer's certification in an amount determined 16 17 by the commission to cover the expenses incurred in the administration of this chapter. A fee received by the commission 18 under this subsection shall be deposited in the state treasury to 19 the credit of the water resource management account. Fees deposited 20 21 under this section may be appropriated only for the administration of this chapter. 22

23 SECTION 3. Section 372.005, Health and Safety Code, as 24 added by this Act, does not apply to a commercial prerinse spray 25 valve that:

26 (1) as of January 1, 2006:

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(A) is in the inventory of a commercial prerinse

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1	spray valve retailer, distributor, lessor, or importer; or
2	(B) has been ordered by a commercial prerinse
3	spray valve retailer, distributor, lessor, or importer and is
4	delivered before February 1, 2006; and
5	(2) is sold before September 1, 2006.
6	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect January 1, 2006.
