1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the recreational facility fee at The University of  
1-11 Texas at San Antonio.

1-12 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-13 SECTION 1. Section 54.543, Education Code, is amended by  
1-14 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as  
1-15 follows:

1-16 (a) The board of regents of The University of Texas System  
1-17 may charge each student enrolled at The University of Texas at San  
1-18 Antonio a recreational facility fee not to exceed:

1-19 (1) \$150 [~~\$100~~] for a term or semester of more than six  
1-20 weeks; [each semester of the regular term] or

1-21 (2) \$75 for a term or semester of six weeks or less.

1-22 (a-1) The recreational facility fee may be used only [summer  
1-23 session] to finance, construct, operate, maintain, or improve  
1-24 student recreational facilities at the university.

1-25 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies  
1-26 beginning with the 2005 fall semester.

1-27 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-28 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-29 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-30 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-31 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
