| 11 | and state holidays: |
| 12 | (A) in each county in which the utility provides |
| 13 | service; or |
| 14 | (B) not more than 20 miles from the residence of |
| 15 | any residential customer if there is no location to receive |
| 16 | payments in the county; and |
| 17 | (2) have an office in a county of this state or in the |
| 18 | immediate area in which its property or some part of its property is |
| 19 | located in which it shall keep all books, accounts, records, and |
| 20 | memoranda required by the commission to be kept in this state. |
| 21 | SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 13, Water Code, is amended |
| 22 | by adding Section 13.146 to read as follows: |
| 23 | Sec. 13.146. DISCONNECTION OF SERVICE. (a) A utility may |
| 24 | not disconnect service of a customer for late payment before the |

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| 1 | 31st day after the date the utility notifies the customer of the |
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| 2 | overdue payment. |
| 3 | (b) After a disconnection caused by the customer's late |
| 4 | payment, a utility may not charge a customer a fee for restoring or |
| 5 | reinstalling service that exceeds \$25 or twice the amount of the |
| 6 | late payment owed, whichever is less. |
| 7 | SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005. |

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
