A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to the eligibility for a commercial establishment to have 3 its name displayed on a specific information logo sign. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 5 SECTION 1. Section 391.093, Transportation Code, is amended 6 by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (h) to read as follows: 7 A commercial establishment, to be eligible to have its 8 (a) name displayed on a specific information logo sign, must provide 9 gas, food, lodging, [or] camping, or pharmacy services and be 10 located not more than three miles from an interchange on an eligible 11 12 highway. If no service participating or willing to participate in the specific information logo sign program is located within three 13 14 miles of an interchange, the commission may grant permits for 15 commercial establishments located not farther than: six miles from the interchange; 16 (1)nine miles from the interchange if no service 17 (2) 18 participating or willing to participate in the program is located within six miles from the interchange; 19 12 miles from the interchange if no service 20 (3) 21 participating or willing to participate in the program is located 22 within nine miles of the interchange; or 15 miles from the interchange if no service 23 (4) participating or willing to participate in the program is located 24

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- 1 within 12 miles of the interchange.
- 2 (h) An establishment that provides pharmacy services must
- 3 operate continuously for 24 hours each day and provide pharmacy
- 4 services for 24 hours each day.
- 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
