- 8 Sec. 143.1055. APPLICANT FOR BEGINNING POSITION IN POLICE
- 9 DEPARTMENT WITH PREVIOUS EXPERIENCE. Notwithstanding any other
- 10 requirement of this chapter, for any applicant for a beginning
- 11 position in the police department who has previous experience as a
- 12 police officer with another police department, the police
- 13 <u>department may:</u>

- 14 (1) modify the police officer training academy
- 15 requirements for the applicant; and
- 16 (2) allow the applicant to take the entrance
- 17 examination before completing the academy training.
- 18 SECTION 2. Section 143.110, Local Government Code, is
- 19 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (c) to
- 20 read as follows:
- 21 (a) Except as provided by <u>Subsection (c) and Section</u>
- 22 143.111, all fire fighters or police officers in the same
- 23 classification are entitled to the same base salary.
- (c) In computing longevity pay and base pay under this

- 1 section for a police officer who has completed the department's
- 2 academy training requirements, the police department may include
- 3 the number of years, not to exceed five, that the police officer
- 4 served in another police department.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 8 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 9 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
