4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 38, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 38.019 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 38.019. DRUG AWARENESS PROGRAM. (a) A school district
8	shall establish a campus drug awareness program.
9	(b) A campus drug awareness program under this section must:
10	(1) monitor drug use on campus;
11	(2) provide a process for tracking reported drug use;
12	(3) provide education services relating to drug use;
13	and
14	(4) establish group drug counseling for middle school,
15	junior high school, and high school students.
16	(c) The agency by rule shall develop a drug awareness
17	program that complies with this section. A school district may:
18	(1) adopt the program developed by the agency; or
19	(2) subject to approval by the commissioner, adopt a
20	program developed by the district.
21	(d) In developing a drug awareness program under Subsection
22	(c)(2), a school district may consult with:
23	(1) parents of district students;
24	(2) educators;

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1 (3) state agencies, local governments, and private 2 entities that provide education services and drug prevention and 3 treatment services in the district; and 4 (4) other groups the district determines appropriate. SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2006-2007 5 6 school year. SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 7 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 8 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 9 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 10 Act takes effect September 1, 2005. 11

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
