- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 28.002, Education Code, is amended by adding Subsection (k-1) to read as follows:
- 7 (k-1) The State Board of Education, in consultation with the
- 8 Department of State Health Services, shall develop a skin cancer
- 9 prevention program that a school district shall use as part of the
- 10 health curriculum under Subsection (a)(2)(B). The program must
- 11 include:
- 12 <u>(1) facts and statistics regarding the negative</u>
- 13 effects of exposure to ultraviolet radiation through tanning and
- 14 sunburn;
- 15 (2) a comprehensive strategy to reduce the risk of
- 16 skin cancer; and
- 17 (3) instruction on accessing updated information and
- 18 educational resources on skin cancer from the Department of State
- 19 <u>Health Services and other appropriate entities.</u>
- SECTION 2. (a) Not later than May 1, 2006, the State Board
- 21 of Education shall develop a skin cancer prevention program as
- 22 provided by Section 28.002(k-1), Education Code, as added by this
- 23 Act.
- 24 (b) A school district shall use the skin cancer prevention

- 1 program developed by the State Board of Education as provided by
- 2 Section 28.002(k-1), Education Code, as added by this Act,
- 3 beginning with the 2006-2007 school year.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
