5	SECTION 1. Section 241.023, Health and Safety Code, is
6	amended by amending Subsection (c) and adding Subsection (c-1) to

8	(c) Except as provided by Subsection (c-1), the [The]

  (c-1) The department may issue one license for multiple

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- 20 (3) there is integration of the organized medical staff of each of the hospitals to be included in the license;

  24 through whom all administrative authority flows and who exercises

- 3 (5) each hospital to be included in the license has a
- 4 single chief medical officer who reports directly to the governing
- 5 body and who is responsible for all medical staff activities of the

- 7 (6) each building of a hospital to be included in the
- 8 license that is geographically separate from other buildings of the
- 9 same hospital contains at least one nursing unit for inpatients,
- 10 unless providing only diagnostic or laboratory services, or a
- 11 combination of diagnostic or laboratory services, in the building
- 12 for hospital inpatients; and
- 13 (7) each hospital that is to be included in the license
- is in compliance with any emergency services regulations issued by
- the department unless it is a hospital located not more than three
- 16 <u>miles away from another hospital that:</u>
- 17 (A) is to be included in the same license; and
- 18 (B) maintains an emergency department.
- 19 SECTION 2. Section 241.003(14), Health and Safety Code, is
- 20 repealed.
- 21 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 22 to an application for a license submitted on or after the effective
- 23 date of this Act. An application for a license submitted before the
- 24 effective date of this Act is covered by the law in effect on the
- 25 date the application was submitted, and the former law is continued
- 26 in effect for that purpose.
- 27 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
