- 4 SECTION 1. Amend Chapter 231, Election Code, by adding 5 Sections 231.010 and 231.011 to read as follows:
- 6 Sec. 231.010. FRIVOLOUS PETITION. (a) On the motion of a
- 7 party or on the judge's own motion, the district judge may determine
- 8 whether the contestant's petition is frivolous or otherwise does
- 9 not state the grounds necessary to maintain the contest.
- 10 (b) If the judge determines that the contestant's petition
- 11 <u>is frivolous or otherwise groundless,</u> the judge may dismiss the
- 12 contest with prejudice.

- Sec. 231.011. AWARD OF ATTORNEY'S FEES. The district judge
- 14 may order the contestant to pay the reasonable attorney's fees of
- the contestee if the judge determines under Section 23.010 that the
