A person 17 bringing an action under this subsection must pay \$500 into the 18 registry of the court. The court shall distribute that amount to 19 the prevailing party on entry of final judgment in the action. 20 21 (c) If the party bringing an action under this section prevails on the merits, the court shall enter an order compelling 22 23 the appraisal district or appraisal review board to comply with the applicable law and ordering that the prevailing party recover its 24
